“for UK transnational higher education to be recognised worldwide as providing education of the highest quality, an outstanding student experience, added value and enhanced outcomes”



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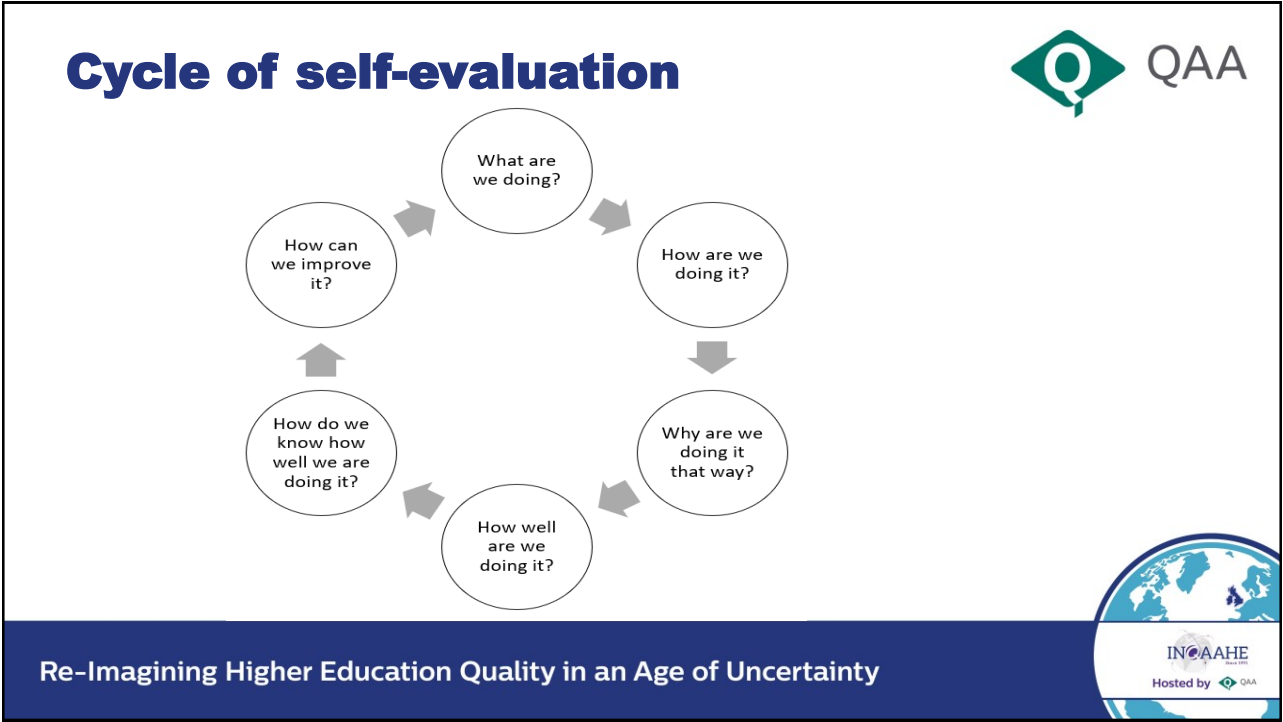
Self-evaluation in enhancement and knowledge transfer for mutual benefit

‘The basic premise in quality enhancement is that wherever you are, you can always improve. Excellence is never a thing achieved or 'job done' but a continuous, purposeful striving’

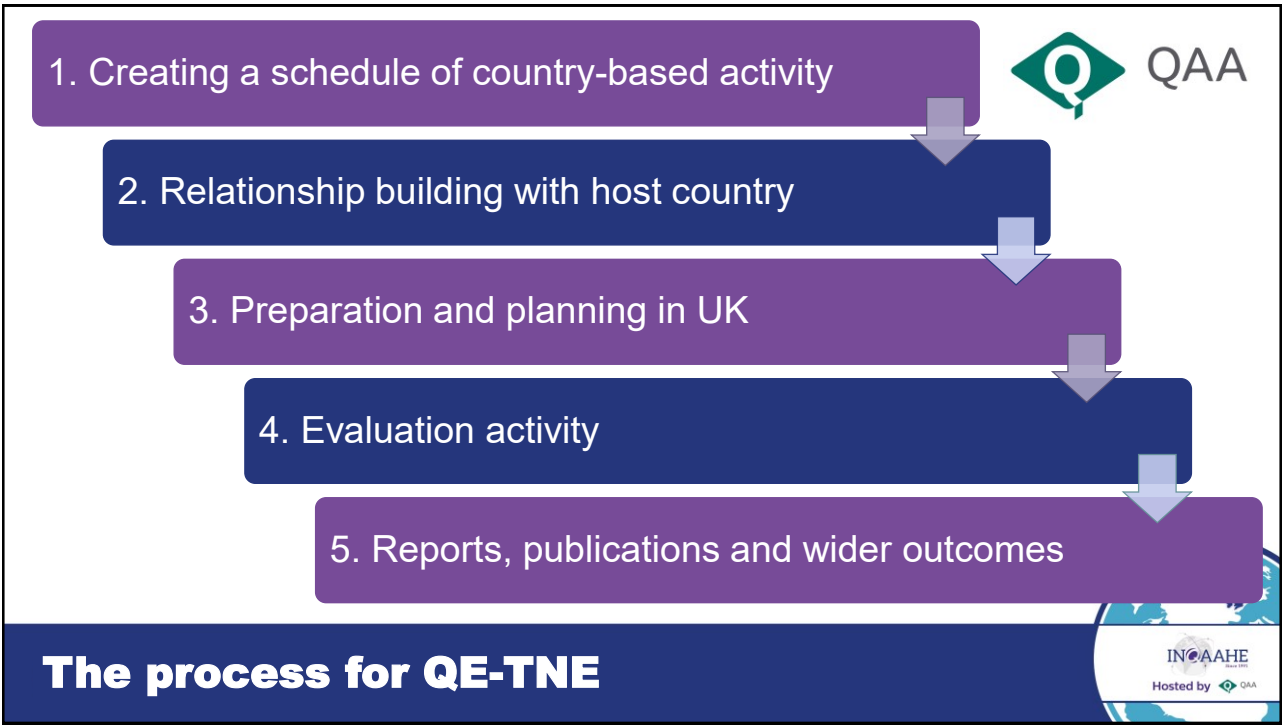
